Visitation Fact Sheet:

- All visitors will be screened for signs and symptoms for COVID-19. Entry will be denied for those with signs or symptoms or those who have had close contact with someone with COVID-19 infection in the prior 14 days (regardless of vaccination status).
 - Hand hygiene must be performed before and after visitation and between contact with residents (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred).
 - The use of surgical masks is required, the facility will provide if needed.
 - Social distancing of at least six feet between persons is expected.
 - Outdoor visitation is always preferred, even when the resident and visitor are fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
 - Visitors should PLEASE stay in the assigned visiting areas and not be wandering the building or Unit.
 - If a visitor tests positive for COVID-19 and has visited the facility within 2 days of their positive result or onset of symptoms, they must notify the facility immediately so we can conduct contact tracing.
 - Per DOH guidance, ALL visitors must show proof of a negative Covid-19 result (either a Negative rapid with the date or a negative PCR every 2 days)
 - The facility encourages all visitors to be fully vaccinated
 - There will be no food or drinks in unsupervised visitation areas (Resident rooms are permitted)
 - Documentation must include the following for each visitor to the nursing home: first and last name of the visitor; physical (street) address of the visitor; daytime and evening telephone number; date and time of visit; and email address, if available.
 - **INFECTION CONTROL GUIDELINES MUST BE FOLLOWED FOR SAFETY!**
- Per NYS Department of Health: Visitors who are unable to adhere to the core principles of COVID-19 infection prevention will not be permitted to visit or will be asked to leave.
